The remaining 18 global objection subjects are:

- (1) all Eligible Class Members should receive the same monetary relief as the Class Agents;
- (2) the monetary relief available to Eligible Class Members is insufficient;
- (3) the attorney fees are unfair;
- (4) the injunctive relief is inadequate;
- (5) Class Counsel are unresponsive;
- (6) the Distribution Plan is unfair;
- (7) the waiver language contained in the Release Form is unfair;
- (8) the injunctive relief does not benefit retirees;
- (9) the USPS should admit liability;
- (10) no unclaimed funds should be paid to a charity;
- (11) the revised settlement does not include any promotions;
- (12) no unclaimed funds should be credited back to the USPS;
- (13) the Global Settlement Notice of Resolution is too strongly worded;
- (14) the Settlement Shares should include compensatory damages;

(15) the Global Settlement does not resolve claims outside the Class definition;

(16) the Settlement Share results in no monetary benefit, because it will be deducted from OWCP benefits;

(17) class members should have the right to proceed with the claims process; and

(18) class counsel is not going to represent individuals who decide to pursue claims in federal court or appeal to the OFO.
